Disconnected Youth:

Estimates of youth disconnection for neighborhood clusters (Public Use Microdata Areas) are from Measure of America's analysis of the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS). They were calculated using ACS microdata spanning 2007 to 2011. For more information on the methodology, see this note on methods and definitions.

White Concentrated Areas of Wealth (ANTI-R/ECAPs):

The goal of this measure is to identify tracts that are opposite to the Racially / Ethnically Concentrated Areas of Poverty (R/ECAPs). The estimates are Measure of America's calculations using ACS data spanning 2006 to 2010. Tracts are designated as ANTI-R/ECAPs if they have a population that is 50 percent or more Non-Hispanic White and if 40 percent or more of households have an annual income of \$200,000 or higher.
